

Choose the CardiacCrash experience that works best for your audience!

Each CardiacCrash session is 1 hour in length and can accommodate up to 40 participants. You can bring the program to your organization in one of two ways:

- Your in-house team can become CardiacCrash facilitators and run sessions themselves.
- Your organization can bring in a certified external instructor to run the program.

Time required of internal champion/s	 Approximately 2-3 hours of online training Approximately 1-2 hours to review support resources to help you deliver a successful session 	 Minimal, once session is scheduled and participants are recruited
Equipment needed	 CPR practice equipment which can be purchased from Heart & Stroke or ask about our DIY options (if needed) 1 piece of equipment per 4 participants 	Most instructors will provide the necessary CPR equipment
Cost	 Currently, the fee for program access has been waived There may be some costs related to time and equipment purchase, if applicable 	 Instructors in the Heart & Stroke network set their own fees On average, a session fee may range from \$500 to \$750
Heart & Stroke support provided	 Personal virtual support from a Heart & Stroke team member who will guide you through the necessary steps to plan and execute a CardiacCrash session 	 Personal virtual support from a Heart & Stroke team member who will help match your organization with a certified instructor, and support with resources to plan the session Payment details will be managed directly between the organization and the instructor
