

Help Improve Digital Applications for Cardiac Rehabilitation

Location: Virtual, Canada-wide.

Description: Researchers at Carleton University are inviting individuals who have participated in cardiac rehabilitation programs to take part in a research study focused on the usability of a mobile application designed to support people in their cardiac rehabilitation journey. This study aims to understand how the app can better assist users in managing their cardiovascular health. Participants will take part in a one-hour video call and navigate through a newly designed web application— feedback will directly help enhance the app's features and accessibility for future patients.

Language: English only.

- Presently enrolled in, or previously enrolled in a Canadian CR program
- Be able to communicate in English
- Have reliable access to the internet and own a tablet or computer

Participant requirements:

- Participation includes one 60-minute video call session.
- Compensation: \$50 for completing the testing session
