

Stakeholder Identification and Analysis for Early Health Technology Assessment of Human Pluripotent Stem Cell-derived Cardiomyocyte Therapies for Heart Failure

Location: Canada-wide

Number of participants: 10 people

Recruitment period: Until August 2026

Description: Researchers at the University of Toronto are conducting a stakeholder engagement study to explore the perspectives, interests, priorities of key stakeholder in the development, and delivery of stem cell therapy for heart failure. Language: English only

Eligibility: Researchers are looking for a diverse group including ranges of age, sex and gender orientation, with lived experience in heart failure or care giver or family member.

Participant requirements: Participation includes one open-ended, semi-structured interview to be conducted virtually over the phone or using Zoom. Interviews will last between 45-60 minutes in duration. Interview participants will receive an individual \$50 gift card for their time and insights.
